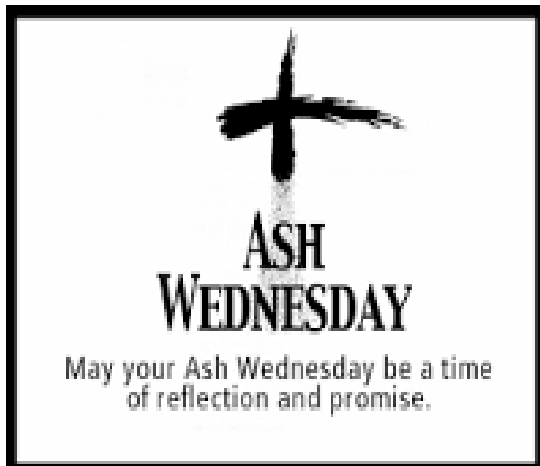

Dear Friends,

Special thanks to the Swains and the Carlins for volunteering to make soup and bread for the first two Thursday Soup and Stations. There are still dates available if anyone would like to volunteer.

Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion please wait until the musicians are finished before distributing Eucharist to the choir members. It is a time of joy and prayer; the musicians while ministerial are still a part of the assembly of the faithful and need time to receive without feeling the stress "to hurry."

I want to apologize to everyone that I may have inadvertently caused anxiety for last Sunday prior to Mass with my comments on emergency measures and exits for the church. I received a message that I should have spoken about other kinds of emergencies, or just put the information in the bulletin, rather than an "active shooter" emergency. The truth is that while the others are important we have really never had, as a country, a real need for this kind of plan. Elementary schools, hospitals, and public places are supposed to have a plan in place and the people who work there are to make sure that the students, employees, participants know procedure. Little children have learned "lock down" procedures and exit routes, they have drills... You need to know, not because I want you to be anxious, but because I want you to be prepared. Not everyone reads the bulletin and many of the folks that come to us are visitors so, as parishioners we need to be able to assist. In many parishes the ushers take over these emergency measures. We have an older parish and we have no "designated" ushers. Know that we, the councils and staff and outside experts will continue to work on safety measures. My anxiety is in failing to do all I can to keep you from anxiety.
