I am hoping that many of you are taking part in the Corned Beef and Cabbage St. Patrick's Day Dinner. If you haven't signed up and want to attend you are most certainly invited to stay. Please feel free to partake and to bring others with you. Sometimes family shows up unexpectedly and we are always full of joy and happy to accommodate all.

I was observing brothers and sisters at Mass this weekend and noticed that some of us are wishy washy on making the Sign of the Cross, one of our most basic prayers.
